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## SUMMARY OF MAIN ARTICLES IN ENGLISH

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### CULTURAL DIVERSITY AND HUMAN DEVELOPMENT: SOME THEORETICAL AND PRACTICAL ISSUES IN VIETNAM TODAY

Culture is the goal and driving force of development, the source and the endogenous strength of human development. In the opposite direction, human development also needs to pay attention to cultural factors, especially cultural diversity. Emphasizing cultural diversity will lead to more equitable, inclusive and sustainable human development outcomes. Conversely, not paying attention to cultural diversity can lead to discrimination and prejudice against people of other cultures and this has negative consequences for human development. By anthropological method and theory, the article provides additional understanding about the relationship between Vietnamese and ethnic minorities place- names in the South, specifically in the Central, the Central Highlands and the Southwest regions. Based on a database of about 3,000 entries from place names that we have collected and published in recent years, the article states that, in the process of expanding the territory to the South and absorbing the names from ethnic minorities, the Vietnamese on the one hand absorbed the original, on the other hand borrowed or modified and finally Vietnamized place- names like today. Therefore, many places in the south of our country not only have pure Vietnamese or Sino-Vietnamese language roots, but also bear the language of ethnic minorities. However, in the current context, the place names of ethnic minorities are increasingly Vietnamized, so they tend to lose their identity. Therefore, it is necessary to preserve the place names of ethnic minorities.
