BOOKS IN SOCIAL SCIENCES LIBRARY REVIEW

PHAN THI MAI HUONG (editor). Research psychosocial aspects of rural resident communities in the context of urbanization. H.: Encyclopedia, 2013, 384 pages, Vb 50738.

Urbanization, essentially is the transition from traditional rural to contemporary urban. In the present context in Vietnam, urbanization brings up prospects, but also challenges for people as well as society. The shortcomings in the social evolution of human-human, human-job, human-society relations, as well as in the management of the society in urbanization areas have posed many issues required to study about people and their mental life. Research on the psychology of farmers, the largest social group, before the social transformation is necessary to contribute to a better understanding of the psychology of this group, and explore the influence of social processes to human psychological traits at the same time. The book consists of 8 chapters.

Chapter 1: An overview of research on the impact of urbanization (foreign, domestic).

Chapter 2: Some theories about the psychosocial problems of the rural residents in the context of urbanization.

MANY AUTHORS. The conflict in the South China Sea is no longer a potential risk. H.: Knowledge, 2012, 314 pages, Vv 11624.

As an important shipping lane with rich marine resources (oil and gas, fisheries), the South China Sea has become a target in ongoing disputes over the past half century, particularly intense in recent years. Therefore, this event inevitably causes deep concerns to many countries and internation. The dynamics and claims of some countries, especially an irrational U-shape line (ox's tongue line) of China have seriously violated the sovereignty, territorial integrity, sovereign rights and

jurisdiction of Viet Nam, the country with more than 3,000 kms of coastline along the South China Sea.

The book's content is a collection of articles from the booklet of Mr. Hång L^a Thä together with Bauvinal and fellowship group, which highlighted the rise of China and how the game of power in the East Asia - Pacific region.

Most of the researchers' articles in this book pay special attention to China with its maritime strategy development and rapid growth of its navy. To do so, it could be said that China aims to use its navy forces as means of political deterrence. In the status of disputes between China and territories and neighboring countries, the Chinese navy has rapidly grown which accidentally sparked fears of a possible conflict in the future. Some authors have analyzed and pointed out the historical evidences which proved a China with agressiveness and chance, and the ability to clash in the South China Sea was possible.

addition, a number of articles analyzed that major countries are jumping into the East Sea in turn, not only the countries with direct benefits, yet for a long time, if the ox's tongue line is realized, powerful countries dependent on sea trade routes will be affected more or less. On the one hand, harmonious keep perfectly relationships in economic cooperation with China, on the other hand, powerful countries such as the U.S., Japan, India ... are on the tenders to find solutions to hold back the rise of Chinese superstrength aspirations. The China East Sea chessboard is no longer personal, how to balance power in the region; however, disputed issues still must rely on power to self-solve. Because, there is no eternal allies - the national interests are permanent only.

DOÃN CHÍNH, CAO XUÂN LONG. **Phan Bội Châu's thoughts about people.** H.: National Politics, 2013, 384 pages, Vb 50734.
