BÙI TẤT THẮNG (Editor in Chief). **Develop rapidly and sustainably Vietnam's economy (2011-2020 period).** Social Sciences Publishing House, 2010, 331 pg, Vb 49274

Develop rapidly and sustainably economy is the pursuit of every country. For less developed countries, rapid and sustainable development of the economy also have been raised as a verbal command which urge, force in the context of competition to catch up with more developed countries.
